
Vision & Mission



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Recap: Implementation Architecture



- ▶ PC-SC/CAs are responsible for the implementation of S2030
 - Monitoring and evaluation
 - Support and guidance to ongoing projects
 - Approval of new project proposals
 - Mid-term review
- PMO supports day-to-day implementation:
 - ► Templates and tools
 - Processes (reporting, prioritization and approval)
 - ▶ Resource management
 - Project-management support



*Caveats: Governance Review & Deployment of PMO

P1 Timely citation of hENs (2022-2023)



Reminder: scope and objectives

- Project addresses the entire value chain of the standardization activity when supporting EU policies and legislation, with the final aim of a timely availability of requested standards and their smooth reference
 - ► Cited deliverables against offered ones > 85% in 2022 & 2023
 - ▶ Positive assessment before publication > 70% at the end of 2023

Progress so far (1):

- ► Monitoring of discussion and findings of ESOs-EC Task Force
- ► Action plan with the main improvements of the processes for citation of standards in the OJEU (life cycle)
- ▶ In particular, the processes defined for the SReq drafting and SReq execution
- ► Mapping of the different bodies contributing to the objective, and their interactions (eg. BTWG 12, BTWG 14, BTs, EPH, ESOs-EC TF)
- ► Take stock and optimize the different actions in progress in those bodies
 - ► E.g. analysis on TCs implementation of CEN-CLC checklist for drafting hEN, guidance on normative references, Fast track procedure for updating normative references after FV

P1 Timely citation of hENs



Progress so far (2)

- ► Focus on specific ESOs-EC TF relevant actions
 - ► E.g., innovative process for hEN drafting, ESOs quality check, new checklists for SReq drafting and for EN assessment
- Proposal for a centralised CCMC quality check of candidate hENs (at least for the short term)
 - ▶ Budget proposal for 3 PMs approved by governing bodies
- ▶ Enlargement of the P1 Team from 9 to 17 persons, representing 14 Members

Next steps

- Monitoring of implementations of the actions in the ESOs-EC TF Action plan under CEN and CENELEC responsibility
 - ▶ In particular, to monitor the pilots launched to test the processes
- ▶ Definition of criteria on how to perform CCMC quality check and possible work plan
- ▶ Definition and implementation of a process to provide support to requesting TCs
- Regular quarterly meeting with problematic TCs
- ▶ Trainings programme
- Deployment of innovative processes on SR execution after the validation of pilots

P2.1 Online Standards Development (OSD)



Reminder: scope and objectives

▶ Provide a browser-based platform for technical bodies to draft their standards which supports all production chain stages including Member commenting and CCMC editing based on XML as the source. Improve quality, transparency and inclusivity. Led by ISO & IEC.

Progress so far:

▶ Piloting "authoring" with 40+ documents (mostly CEN; looking for more CENELEC pilots). Positive feedback.

Next steps:

▶ "Member commenting" and "CCMC editing" coming in 2023. May become mandatory for drafting as early as 2025.

P2.2 Smart Standards



Reminder: scope and objectives

- ➤ Transform the form of standards content to satisfy customer demands for additional capabilities, e.g. for granular search, import, matching, and change notifications. Aiming for "Level 3 (sentence centric)" capabilities by end of 2024 including holistic impacts on business model, Internal Regulations, etc.
- ► Attempting to align with ISO/IEC initiatives which have different goals (target "Level" and target date).

Progress so far:

► Collected diverse customer requirements (user stories); recommended changes to Guide 10 (copyright); selected FontoXML as part of the toolset.

Next steps:

Pilots.

P3 Assessing User Needs



- Reminder: scope and objectives
 - ► Mapping and health check of how Members assess User Needs
- Progress so far:
 - ▶ Members Survey: benchmarking exercise, assessing the status quo. How Members identify and process strategic and tactical user needs (+-75% response rate)
 - ► Interim Report: preliminary analysis and identification of issues for follow-up
 - ► Follow-up interviews with selected Members: additional detail, insight from best practices and representative examples
- Next steps:
 - ► Assessment Report (Q1 '23)
 - ► Conceive P3 contd. '23 (For PC SC approval Feb. '23)

P4 - Diversity & Representation



- Reminder: scope and objectives
 - Survey to collect data to provide a better understanding of the current state-of-play of the Representation of the stakeholder categories in CEN and CENELEC Technical Bodies
 - Survey outcome → Gap-analysis & identification of needs to be addressed, for recommendations to CEN and CENELEC governance to further increase the inclusive and diverse representation of the stakeholders in CEN and CENELEC technical work

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P4 - Diversity & Representation



Progress so far

- Survey designed, launched & closed (4 months) → 151 valid responses = 36,7% response-rate (112 active CEN TCs (33,7%) + 33 active CLC TCs (53,3%) + 6 active JTCs (33,3%))
- Currently finalizing assessment of data & gap-analysis regarding the diversity of stakeholders' categories in TBs

Next steps

- ▶ Report with survey outcome and preliminary recommendations to be finalized in Q1-2023
- ➤ To be further elaborated with results from **P4-Phase 2 (2023 project)**, for comprehensive project proposal based on both surveys' findings, by end of 2023

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P5 Strategic International Action Mechanism (SIAM)



- **▶** Reminder: scope and objectives
 - Strengthen the CEN and CENELEC Members' strategic approach to topics proposed in ISO & IEC
 - ► Identify strategic topics of European interest that could be addressed in ISO & IEC

Progress so far:

- ▶ **Mechanism key principles** developed by P5 Team and presented to the PC
- ► Launch of the **Pilot Phase** under the **BT working processes** as a means to pilot and further optimize the Mechanism
- ► Identification of **3 pilot groups**:
 - 1. European strategic autonomy Access to critical materials Specialty metals and minerals (AFNOR led)
 - 2. Chips security (AFNOR-CEF and/or DKE led)
 - 3. Interoperability of data (DS-led)

P5 Strategic International Action Mechanism (SIAM)



Next steps:

- ► Follow up 3 pilots on proposed topics (Q4 2022)
- Establish a list of possible topics (Q4 2022)
- ► Keep track of new topics in ISO and IEC (Q4 2022)
- ► Take stock with VPs Tech (Q1 2023)
- Midterm Assessment & report to PC in May 2023
- ▶ Reconvene P5 project team Q3 2023 to assess SIAM effectiveness and report to PC
- Optimized mechanism fully operational from 2024

Members Engagement



- Consultation: how to solicit and transform YOUR ideas into future projects?
- Participation: how to get YOU in the driver's seat to implement them?
- Communication: how to keep you informed & get your feedback

Consultation: soliciting & developing project proposals



Roadmap to:

- Solicit project ideas from YOU
 - ► Through request for project ideas (late Q4 2022 early Q1, survey 1)
 - Ideas can be submitted by single Member or on behalf of a group of Members
- Validation & Prioritization by YOU
 - ► Members survey 2 (end Q1)
- Co-develop project proposals
 - Proposing Member(s) & CCMC-PMO
- Ensure a predictable & repeatable process to develop and validate projects
- ► Final decision on projects remains with PC SC or CAs (Q2)

• Request for project proposals

 Initial vetting (CCMC-PMO) & prioritization (Members) of project proposals

 Development of costed project proposals (CCMC-PMO & proposing Member(s))

Approval in principle by PC SC or CAs

Budget Approval by CEN/AG & CENELEC/AG (June)

 Project initiation (e.g., call for participation, scheduling)

*Caveats: Governance Review & Deployment of PMO

Participation: Members in the driver's seat



Motivation matters

- Projects require work, team members are expected to contribute: no observers
- ▶ Limited reliance on CCMC
- ▶ Projects are not reference/advisory/governance groups where Members send representatives to stay informed: no alternates – 1 team member per Member

Profiles matter

Expertise and added value to the project is key, needs may change over project lifetime

Size matters


► Too big to be efficient vs. too small to carry the workload, needs change.

- ► Up to **Project**Leaders to launch
 calls for
 participation, confirm
 and change team
 composition, enforce
 rules of engagement.
- Under development: General Participation Policy to guide and support Project Leaders

Communication: 2-way street



- Formal reporting to PC SC through PMO
 - ► All PC SC materials = accessible to Members
- Informal Updates (options)
 - Presentations to governance and advisory groups
 - ► S2030 Members Webinars
 - ▶ Project-specific Webinars
 - Dashboard with project overviews
- ► Include transparency on financial impact over mid- to long-term
- S2030 Breakout Sessions alongside AG meetings
